## Instructions on how to sign-up to receive NASS publications

- 1. Go to this website: https://usda.library.cornell.edu/?locale=en
- 2. You will see the page below. Click the **Sign-up** button located to the right of your screen.



3. Once you click the sign-up button, you will see the following. Type your email address and create a password then click the sign-up button at the bottom of the screen.



You will see the following message once your sign up is completed.

A message with a confirmation link has been sent to your email address. Please follow the link to activate your account. If you do not receive the email in your inbox, please check your spam folder.

4. To activate your account, you need to go to your email (the one you used to create your account) and click the confirmation link. The email you receive will be sent by "USDA ESMIS" and appear as shown below (If you do not see the message in your inbox check you spam or junk folders). Click the confirm account bottom

1. Now you need to subscribe to the reports that you are interested in. To do that search for the report of interest (for this example I used Crop Progress).



2. I received several responses; however this is the one I want to subscribe to.
